ALLEGED CORRUPTION AND MISMANAGEMENT OF FUNDS BY MR. SENDAULA YASIN, ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER URBAN INSPECTION MINISTRY OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT

The Inspectorate of Government received a complaint of alleged corruption and mismanagement of funds by officials of the Ministry of Local Government (MoLG) during the FY 2014/2015.

Mr. Sendaula Yasin, Assistant Commissioner Urban Inspection MoLG was indicated to have received UGX 111million to carry out field activities but did not put all the money to the intended use.

Investigations carried out established that:

- i. Mr. Sendaula Yasin was advanced a total of UGX 84,099,000 by MoLG for inland travels in the Financial Year 2014/2015 to conduct official activities.
- ii. In some of the places where verification was done during investigations, no evidence was obtained to show that Mr. Sendaula Yasin conducted activities for which he received facilitation. In addition, irregularities were found in some of the accountability documents he furnished to MoLG.
- iii. Mr. Sendaula Yasin presented false receipts for fuel worth UGX 10,044,000 in his accountability to the Under Secretary Finance and Administration MoLG.

- iv. Mr. Sendaula Yasin has requested to refund the money UGX 10,044,000/= for which false fuel receipts were presented to MoLG as part of his accountability for the funds advanced to him.

Given the above findings, as detailed in the report attached, it is recommended that:

- i. You ensure that Mr. Sendaula Yasin, Assistant Commissioner Urban Inspection Ministry of Local Government refunds a total of **UGX 10,044,000** to the Inspectorate of Government Asset Recovery Account Number **003030088000007** at Bank of Uganda within **45 days** from the date of receipt of this letter.
- ii. You submit Mr. Sendaula Yasin to Public Service Commission for appropriate disciplinary action.

Please inform this office of the action taken within one month of receipt of this letter.
