EXTENSION OF DEADLINE TO SUBMIT DECLARATION OF INCOME, ASSETS AND LIABILITIES 2021

With reference to Article 230(2) of the Constitution of the Republic of Uganda, which gives the Inspector General of Government powers to make such orders and give such directions as are necessary and appropriate in the circumstances during the course of his or her duties, I hereby **extend the declaration period for 2021 from 31st March 2021 to 23rd April 2021.**

Leaders are reminded that failure to declare their income, Assets and Liabilities is a breach of the Leadership Code Act, 2002 as amended which attracts prosecution by IG before the Leadership Code Tribunal.

Below are the guidelines to the leaders.

- 1) Leaders who have already been registered in Inspectorate of Government Online Declaration System (IG-ODS) are advised to visit the IG website and use the **“Self-Invitation Module”**.
- 2) New Leaders who have not been registered in the IG-ODS are advised to visit the IG Website and use the **“Self-Registration Module”**
- 3) For any **inquires/requests** leaders are encouraged to visit the IG website and make use of the **“Service Request(Inquires) Module”**
- 4) Leaders are discouraged from the use of telephone lines because of the congestion.
- 5) Trainings on how to use the IG-ODS will continue via Webinar **ID 957 1628 7613, Pass code 322978** every Tuesday and Thursday at 10am
- 6) Videos to guide leaders on the declaration process are available on IG website, facebook, twitter and You Tube channels

Note that there will be no further extension of the declaration period beyond 23rd April 2021. The system will not be accessible after mid-night.
