CORRUPTION AND MISMANAGEMENT OF PUBLIC FUNDS BY PUBLIC OFFICIALS AT UGANDA AIRLINES

The Inspectorate of Government is **conducting an investigation into** various acts of mismanagement of public funds by Public officials at **Uganda National Airlines Company Ltd (UNACL)**. UNACL is a Company owned by the Government of Uganda with 100% shareholding.

In the course of the investigations, the Inspectorate of Government summoned **Mr. Cornwell Muleya, former Chief Executive Officer (CEO)** to give information and facilitate the investigations. **Mr. Muleya** failed to heed to the summons.

Under **Section 26 and 27** of the **Inspectorate of Government Act, 2002**, where a person on whom a summon has been served does not attend as ordered, the Inspectorate of Government may issue a warrant of arrest to apprehend that person and bring him/her before the Inspectorate of Government.

Further, under **Section 35 of the Inspectorate of Government Act, 2002** a person who willfully and without lawful justification disobeys an order of the Inspectorate of Government for his or her attendance commits an offence.

In light of the above provisions of the law, today the 21st /06/2022, **Mr. Cornwell Muleya** has been arrested and charged with the offence of failure to attend before the Inspectorate of Government when so ordered.

This is to therefore warn all members of the public against disobedience of the Inspectorate of Government orders. We urge you to co-operate with the Inspectorate of Government whenever you are called upon.
