REPORT ON ALLEGED POSSESSION OF FALSE /FORGED ACADEMIC DOCUMENTS BY SOME STAFF MEMBERS AT RWENTANGA FARM SCHOOL IN MBARARA DISTRICT

The Inspectorate of Government received a complaint in which it was alleged that:-

- 1) Mr. Charles Tushabe Kashaija used forged documents: Uganda Certificate of Education (UCE), appointment letter and posting instructions to access the Government payroll at salary scale U4;
- 2) Ms. Roseline Nabimanya used a forged appointment letter and forged posting instructions to access the Government payroll at salary scale U4;
- 3) Ms. Beth Kyomugisha, a Stenographer Secretary used a forged appointment letter and forged posting instructions to access the Government payroll;
- 4) Ms. Miriam Tworekirwe used a forged appointment letter to access the Government payroll in 2010;
- 5) Mr. Edward Tumwine used a forged promotional appointment letter to access a higher salary on the government payroll.

Investigations conducted by this office established that:

- a) The appointment letters used by Mr. Charles Tushabe Kashaija, Ms. Roseline Nabimanya, Ms. Beth Kyomugisha, Ms. Miriam Tworekirwe and Mr. Edward Tumwine were authentic. The allegation therefore that Mr. Charles Tushabe Kashaija, Ms. Roseline Nabimanya, Ms. Beth Kyomugisha, Ms. Miriam Tworekirwe and Mr. Edward Tumwine used forged appointment letters to join service was found not to be true.
