REQUEST FOR REVIEW OF RECOMMENDATIONS OF INSPECTOR GENERAL OF GOVERNMENT FOR PROF. MOSES JOLOBA TO RESIGN FROM POSITION OF A LECTURER AT MAKERERE UNIVERSITY OR DIRECTOR UGANDA SUPRA NATIONAL REFERENCE LABORATORY

This refers to your letter dated 14th March 2019 addressed to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Health and copied to me, in which you stated that the finding in our report that Prof. Moses Joloba holds two positions in two institutions of Government and therefore draws salaries from each of them was not correct.

Our recommendation for Prof Moses Joloba to resign from either being a Lecturer at Makerere University or Director Uganda SRL was based on facts and document presented to us during investigations as follows:

1. Dr. Moses Joloba was first appointed into the service of Makerere University as a Lecturer in 1997. He is currently a Professor in the Department of Medical Microbiology, School of Biomedical Sciences College of Health Sciences. He earns a salary drawn from the Consolidated Fund (**Annex 1**).
2. By a letter dated 23rd September 2004, Prof. Moses Joloba was appointed to head NTRL. This appointment had no salary attached to it (**Annex 2**).
3. However, in a letter dated 13th April 2017, Prof. Moses Joloba was offered an appointment on contract as Director Supra National TB Reference Laboratory (SRL) for a period of twenty-four months effective 1st November 2015 and renewable subject to performance and availability of funds. The appointment was issued by PS Ministry of Health and it entitled Prof. Moses Joloba to a monthly gross salary of UGX. 11,716,010/= and 10% of gross salary remittance to NSSF as employer's
