SAMUEL SEMPEBWA, male adult Ugandan aged 52 years, **SENIOR ACCOUNTS ASSISTANT, SCHOOL OF CLINICAL OFFICER KABAROLE DISTRICT** was charged at the Anti-Corruption Court on Friday 13th October 2017 and was later granted bail.

Sempebwa appeared before His Worship Fred Peter Lochomin. And was charged with the count of CONFLICT OF INTEREST C/S 9(1) and (2)(c) of the Anti-Corruption Act.

SAMUEL SEMPEBWA, in March 2015, while employed as Senior Accounts Assistant (Bursar) at the School of Clinical Officers in Kabarole District, in the course of his official duties as member of the evaluation committee of the said School knowingly failed to disclose the nature of his interest in M/S Hasir Enterprises Limited and participated in the deliberations of the evaluation committee meeting held on 25th March 2015 where his company M/S Hasir Enterprises Limited was selected as the best evaluated bidder for supply of foodstuffs to the School of Clinical Officers in Kabarole.

He will appear in court on 27th October 2017 at 2:00pm
